During a recent time of prayer at Temple El-Roï, some people were asked to give their testimonies. Pastor Pierre’s wife, gave this testimony:

“I was out in the kitchen and left our son (he is one year old) in the house. When I returned to pick him up I found a snake circling the child and the baby trying to catch the snake. My husband was at a prayer meeting at El Roï, so he was not available to help.



I did not know what to do. I knew I had to do something so I went into the house, picked and the child and ran to the church which is next to the house. My husband and another man quickly came back to the house. By the time they arrived the snake was outside and they managed to kill it.”

This reminds me about the Word of God promising to protect us and even poisonous snakes will not harm us. We are grateful to God for keeping all of

us under the shadow of His wings and not allowing any evil to harm us.

Village evangelism

In early March, Pastor Pierre held a week of prayer and fasting. In a three-day evangelistic campaign, ACTS sent four teams of five people each to five villages and Saonré. During the three days, 195 people gave their lives to the Lord.

Ag projects

We were looking for a way to water the vegetable garden and fruit trees at our farm. The German Embassy solved our problem by giving ACTS a generator to turn the handle of the pump. This pump supplies water for the 250 banana, papaya

and other trees we planted during the short rainy season we had in 2011.



During the long dry season the young trees must be kept watered. We are hoping to plant more vegetables during the next rainy season beginning in July. Please pray for rain and an abundant harvest to improve the meals fed to the orphans.
