- The secondary school now has a computer lab for student’s use. This lab will make a great difference in the learning skills of all those attending ACTS Schools.



- Another innovative thing is the establishment of library for the use of all students; this is going to improve their reading skills.

A new partner promised library shelving, tables and chairs for the library before we even asked! They will arrive in a container with a shipment of food from Heaven Sent Ministries.

- It is important for all students to be exposed to the Word of God during their time at the ACTS’ schools. We have purchased more than 200 bibles in French for their use.

Last July we share with you some News about a young girl Assana Kabré who was forced to care for her younger sibling when her parents passed away due to AIDS. We have recently been able to buy a bicycle and a sewing machine for this young girl who is struggling to support herself and her

younger brother. The brother is at this moment in hospital as he is infected by AIDS. I feel very sorry for Assana, who has taken up the responsibilities of “mother and father.” We are doing what we can to assist her.
